## NOTES

Estimates based on census tract data as reported in the Census Transportation Planning Package, which is derived from the American Community Survey (ACS), 2012/2016. The middle year of the ACS 2012/2016, and is likely the most representative year.

CBD census tracts are the same as in the $3^{\text {rd }}$ Edition. Total employment in the CBD and transit work trips to the CBD are scaled upward by the percentage difference between the metropolitan area total employment and the total employment in the census tracts as reported by CTPP.

CBDs are all in the first named municipality of the metropolitan area, except in the case of Virginia Beach-Norfolk, where the historic CBD is in the city of Norfolk.
