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# U.S. CENSUS NET IMMIGRATION DATA REVEALS GROWTH ACROSS METROPOLITAN AREAS

## Immigrants Choose Cores & Suburbs

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### SUMMARY

This report summarizes US Bureau of the Census international migration in the United States between metropolitan areas, their cores, suburbs and other areas from 2000 to 2004. It is based upon the latest available county migration information at the date of publication.

The nation's metropolitan areas with more than 5,000,000 population experienced net international migration gain of nearly 3,000,000 (Table 1). The largest international immigration gains were in metropolitan areas with between 1,000,000 and 5,000,000 population and metropolitan areas with from 250,000 to 500,000 population (Figure 1). All size classifications experienced net gains of international and domestic migration, with the exception of areas with between 10,000 and 50,000 residents.

## International Migration: 2000-2004 BY POPULATION OF AREA (CSA/MSA & SMALLER)



### HIGHLIGHTS

#### Trends: Metropolitan Areas Over 1,000,000

Immigration gains totaled approximately 4.3 million in the 53 metropolitan areas with more than 1,000,000 in 2000.

- The gains were concentrated in 11 metropolitan areas, with a total of 3.2 million new immigrant residents.
- New York had the greatest immigrant gain, at nearly 800,000.
- Los Angeles ranked second with 630,000 new immigrant residents.
- San Francisco<sup>1</sup> (306,000), Chicago (281,000) and Miami gained more than 250,000 new residents.
- Dallas-Fort Worth, Washington-Baltimore, Houston Atlanta, Boston and Phoenix each gained between 100,000 and 200,000 new immigrant residents.

The largest percentage gains were generally in the same metropolitan areas.

- Miami had the largest gain, at 5.6 percent, followed by San Francisco, at 4.3 percent.
- Six metropolitan areas experienced gains of between 3.0 and 4.0 percent, including (in order), Los Angeles, Houston, New York, Dallas-Fort Worth, Phoenix, Austin and Las Vegas.

Perhaps indicating a new trend, 42 percent of the new immigrants settled in the suburbs.

- The core counties continued to gain a majority of immigrants, but in 14 metropolitan areas, more immigrants settled in the suburbs than in the cores.
- In Washington-Baltimore and San Francisco, more than seven times as many immigrants moved into the suburbs as the cores.
- In Atlanta, more than four times as many immigrants settled in the suburbs as in the core.
- In Richmond, more than three times as many immigrants settled in the suburbs than in the core.
- In seven metropolitan areas, the cores gained more than 90 percent of the new immigrant population (in order): Las Vegas, Phoenix, Columbus, San Antonio, Tampa-St. Petersburg and Memphis. The small suburban shares may be as much the result of these areas having particularly large core counties as opposed to any greater concentration of immigrants in such cores.

TOP 10 METROPOLITAN AREAS (CSA/MSA)



11-20 RANKED METROPOLITAN AREAS (CSA/MSA)




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### Trends: All Metropolitan Areas:

Among the total 729 areas, net international migration was 5.255 million (Table 5).

- The largest percentage gain was in Liberal, Kansas, at 7.1 percent. Coincidentally, Liberal experienced the fourth largest domestic migration loss (see Demographia report on domestic migration).
- Other areas experiencing greater than five percent international migration gains compared to their 2000 population were (in order) Arcadia, Florida, Edwards, Colorado, Clewiston, Florida, Dodge City, Kansas, Miami, Florida and Guymon, Oklahoma.

### NOTES

Combined Statistical Areas (CSA) are used where they exist. CSA's include Metropolitan Statistical Areas and Micropolitan Areas (MSA).<sup>2</sup> Where CSA's do not exist, the Metropolitan Statistical Area (MSA) is used.

Core are the county in which the metropolitan area's largest city is located, with the following exceptions:

Dallas-Fort Worth: Dallas and Tarrant Counties  
 Minneapolis-St. Paul: Hennepin and Ramsey Counties

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<sup>2</sup> The abbreviation "MSA" is used for both metropolitan statistical areas and micropolitan statistical areas, since the only difference between the two is a population classification.

New York: All five counties (boroughs) of the city of New York  
Tampa-St. Petersburg: Hillsborough and Pinellas County  
Washington-Baltimore: Cities of Baltimore and Washington

Suburban counties are all counties in the metropolitan area outside the core.

One metropolitan area (San Diego) consists of only one county, which is considered the core county. As a result, no suburban data is shown for San Diego.
